

Creating Strategic Intent

Culture is a corporate way of life that forms and shapes individual lives.

Strategic Intent describes how we intend to integrate our core values into every aspect of our life together.

Strategic Intent also describes who is responsible, when things will be executed, and how progress will be measured. Every key ministry area must be addressed in the strategic plan by focusing on how each value will be incorporated and realized.

The goal is to create a consistent culture throughout the congregation into which people are continually immersed.

People are being immersed into the same values whether they sing in the choir, help with altar guild, attend a youth function, or experience worship.

Strategic Intent Three-Year Process

• First 6-months – Assessing everything

 Ministries that align with the values will be strengthened through intentional investment

- Ministries that don't align will either be transformed to align, removed, or replaced with something new
 What do you need to achieve the vision?
 - Facility
 - Staff
 - Leaders
 - Finances

Strategic Intent Three-Year Process

Next 18-months – Working the plan

 Leaders are identified, equipped, and unleashed
 to follow the strategic intent
 Ministries are developed according to the strategic intent
 The timeline is adjusted as necessary
 Metrics are used to assess progress

Strategic Intent Three-Year Process

• Final 12-months

 \odot Everything is evaluated based on the strategic intent

- What has gone well?
- Where do you see the plan being effective?
- To what do you attribute the success?
- If goals did not get achieved, why not? What went wrong? (e.g. poor leadership or execution, not enough resources, lack of passion or energy, poor timing)

 \odot What adjustments need to be made?

- \odot The Strategic Intent gets revised and updated
- Remember that the Strategic Intent is to be a fluid document that changes as we go based on our experiences
