Especially when it comes to the "teaching timeline"

Jesus has been talking about some things that are...

"unexpected"

Peter

"Didn't I tell you that you are the Messiah when we were in Caesarea Philippi?"

Why?

Don't tell anyone!

Your perspective is too small in terms of what is possible.

They needed to understand what it means to call Jesus the Messiah

Death

The Church says "NO" to Jesus too often.

How is this Teaching Relevant?

We need to understand "crosses"

How are you (we) hindering others from seeing Jesus as the Messiah?

This is not for the individual It's for the sake of the community.

I wear a cross because of what Jesus did for me

OR

I wear a cross Setting aside MY agenda for Jesus' agenda

For ALL People

How has St John's been called to align itself, for the sake of the gospel, in our community?

Imagined cost of speaking up is almost always higher than the actual cost

The Cost to our Imagination is High...

When we keep our insights to ourselves

Speaking up is a skill

We can only improve it with practice
